You are invited to tender for the lease with option to purchase of Crown Land for Commercial use only.

Tenders will be considered for sites No. 1 and No. 2 in the Township of Pic, fronting on Highway No. 17 at the intersection of the Marathon Access Road.

The location of these two parcels are shown on plans of record in the Department of Lands and Forests at Geraldton, Ontario, and at the Chief Ranger's Office at Terrace Bay, Ontario.
