When we got in side we didn't know which way to go because everything was so fantastic we could hardly believe our eyes. We tried so many things our fingers were sore from pressing buttons.

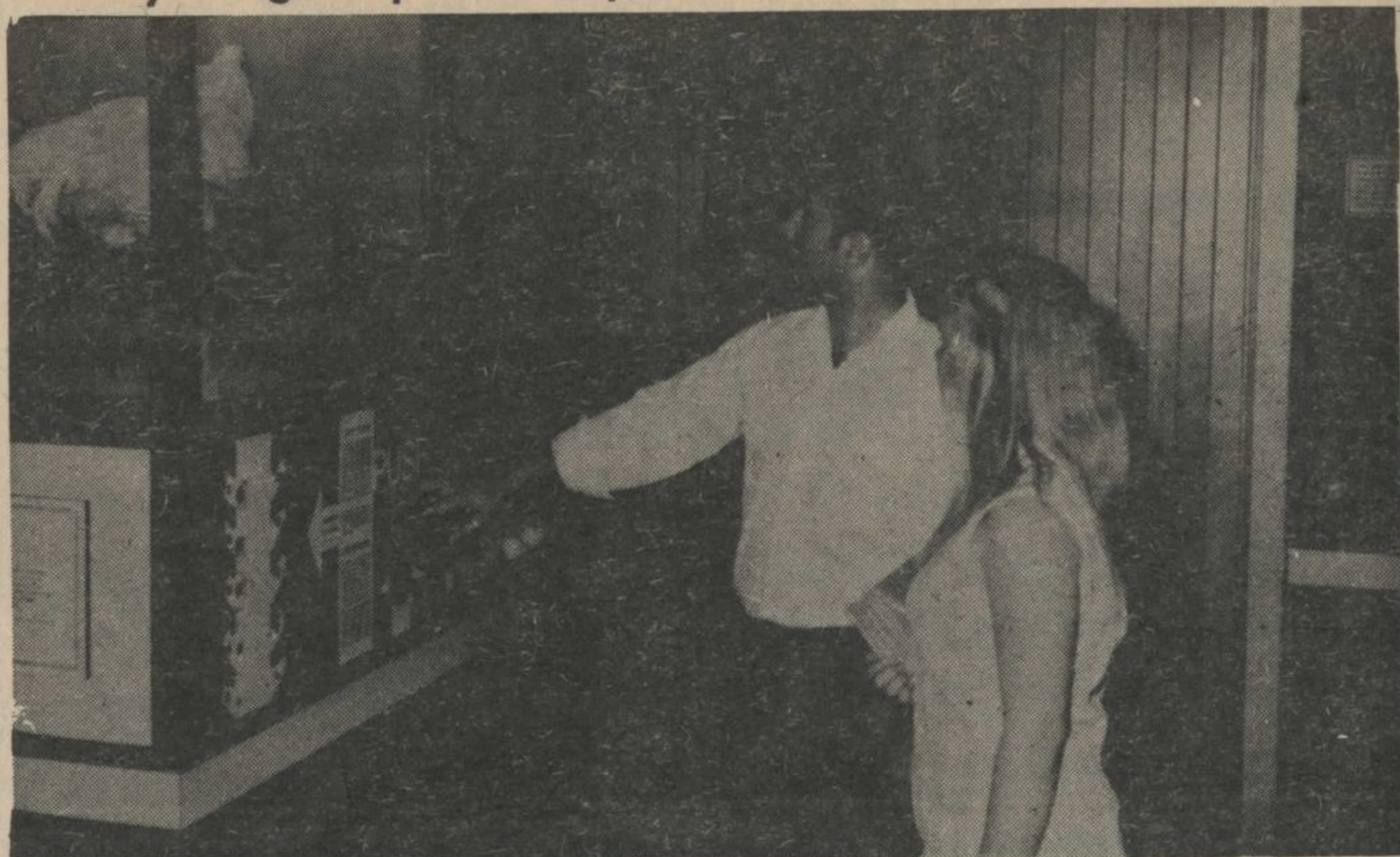
