Spring flowering bulbs. Bulbs are among the easiest of all plants to grow. All you do is dig a hole - six inches deep and six inches apart for tulips, daffodils, and hyacinths. Drop the bulb in, pointed end up and sit back waiting for Spring when the bulbs will burst forth into a glorious display of colour.
