none of which were previously available to all students. In addition to these many of the traditional courses have been updated and revised.

Enrolment is 15% above last year with 246 students presently registered. Seventy-five of these students are from out of town, eleven of whom are boarding in Terrace Bay. These youngsters are able to have the special education this school offers because of the generosity of local citizens who have opened their homes to them.

The staff has increased to twenty-one full time and part time teachers. New teachers whom we welcome to Terrace Bay High School are: - Mr. R.J.
