Alberta at the end of that year, British Columbia, the Yukon and the Northwest Territories in the Spring of 1973, and Quebec and the rest of Ontario early in 1974.

"The CODE is essential," Mr. Cote said, "in order to allow us to handle efficiently the spiralling mail volumes and increased traffic congestion in the country's larger post offices."

The CODE is alpha-numeric-composed of both letters and numbers - and always takes the form of ANA NAN, where "A" represents a letter of the alphabet and "N" a number from 0 to 9. There is a space between the first three and the last three characters. - more next week.....

C. OF C. REQUEST LOBBY OPEN SUNDAY

A new and updated brochure is being prepared. This new brochure will have an insert which will contain the names of the members of the Terrace Bay Chamber of Commerce. Members and prospective members will soon be contacted.

The Chamber recently made a request that the local post office box lobby be opened for a period of two hours on Sunday evenings to enable our citizens who travel on the weekend, the opportunity to pick up their mail and newspapers. We are in receipt of the following letter from the Area Manager, Canada Post Office -
Quote: " In February, 1969 the Post Office Department decided that in order to give additional service to lock box customers, lock box lobbys of all Staff and Semi-staff Post Offices be opened on a 24 hour basis.

This was authorized with the stipulation that in the event of vandalism the local Postmaster, in conjunction with his Director, has the authority to close the lock box lobby and return to daytime hours of service.
