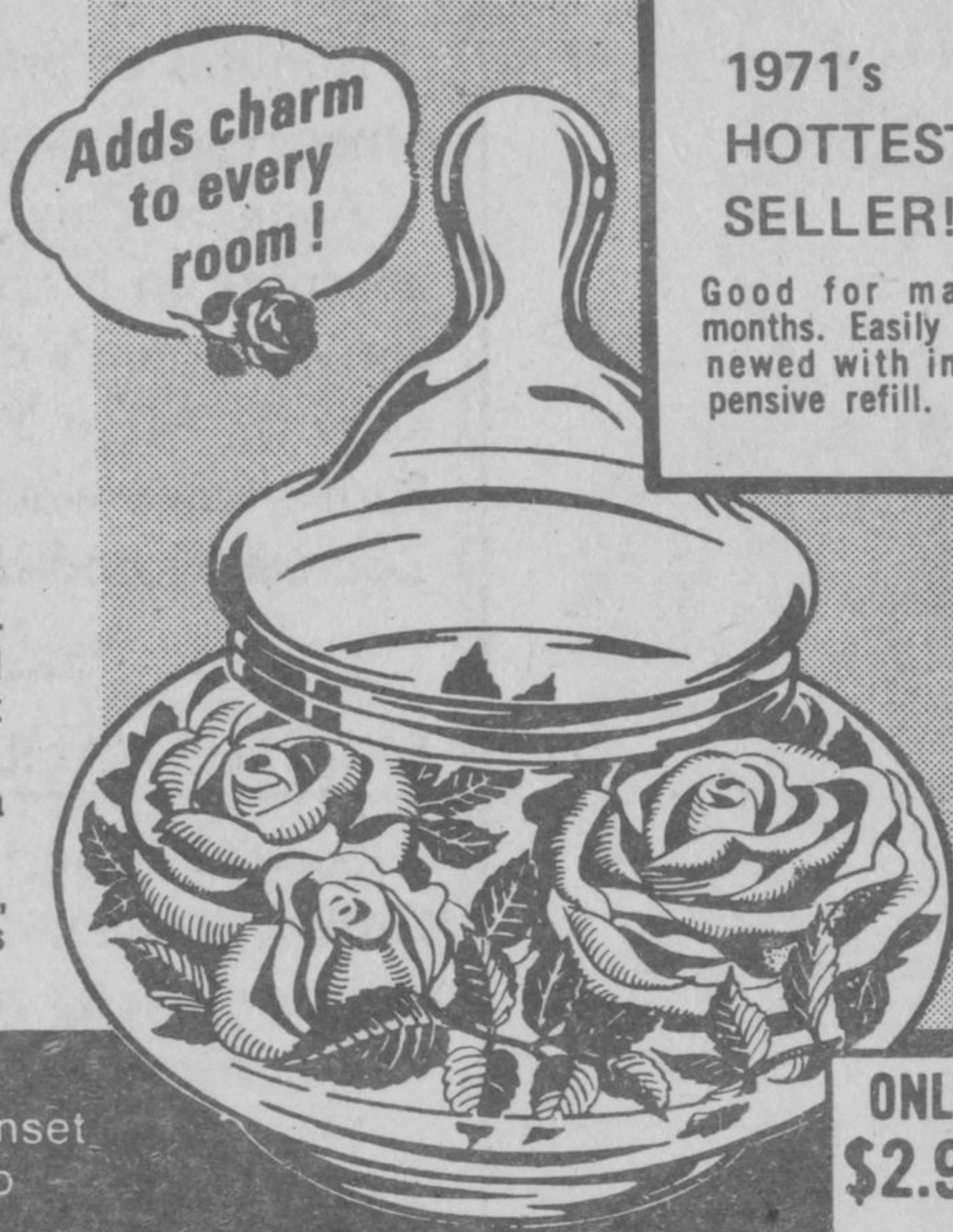

relationships. Greater flexibility in use of staff, closer contact. Identification of both schools as one institution serving both communities.

Greater understanding by Principal of the "Grade 13 Problem" with resulting benefits to students. Simplification of administrative structure.

Possible Disadvantages: - Lack of support by parents, staff, students and civic groups; Reduction in accessibility of Principal to staff, students, parents; Danger of "polarization" of courses. (This is capable of control and regardless of one or two Principals, changes in course offerings in each school will have to be made).

Principal would have to maintain two offices; Initial disruption; Job of Principal will be more demanding than at present, particularly in public relations and co-ordination; Principal will be in each school half-time or less. Conflicts between Principal and Vice-Principal; Loss of staff.

This Committee has been asked for facts with no recommendations. Alternatives to the proposal from Committee members as individuals are:

1. Delay implementation for one year with further study.
2. Keep present Principals with one as supervising or Senior Principal over both schools.
3. Status quo while a thorough study made of the idea.
4. K-13 to be considered.
5. All secondary schools with Vice-Principals or Principals and with one Supervising Principal - i.e. One Supervising Principal, 4

Principals or Vice-Principals as opposed to 4 Principals and 4 Vice-Principals.

### Special Committee Report - cont'd from page 12 . . . . .

There is a major difference in the environment prevailing in each of the two schools. This came out so strongly in the discussions that it was almost a "night and day" comparison.

The student drop-outs did not appear to be adequately prepared to handle the significant changes in the school environment when they transferred from Grade XII-Terrace Bay to Grade XIII in Schreiber.

There do not appear to be any problems at the student level between Terrace Bay and Schreiber Grade XIII students.

The concept of non-compulsory attendance in Grade XIII is questionable and did not appear to be well handled by the drop-outs who were interviewed.

Bussing of students from Terrace Bay to Schreiber for Grade XIII did not appear to present any serious problems.

Advantages and Disadvantages (of integration of the schools) - Each Committee Member was asked to list the advantages and disadvantages. Here fact and opinion became intertwined.

Possible Advantages: - Savings in Cost: (some saving is a fact). The amount suggested by various Committee Members varied from \$8,000, where the member felt it would require full-time Vice-Principals, to \$16,650, which included extra costs for mileage and meals and other bus runs per day (the proposal does not call for full-time Vice-Principals).

One philosophy in both schools resulting in: improved co-ordination of departments, courses; improved inter-school
