Some of his observations as he assumes his new responsibilities:

- on government - "I can see the government-industry partnership coming closer together. There is a growing need for greater political recognition and appreciation of the role of the private sector in our economic and social well-being. We will continue to work actively with government to achieve this mutual objective."

- on corporate citizenship - "Our companies believe in being good corporate citizens in the communities where we operate and, indeed, in the whole country. We are aware of our responsibilities in environmental control and in other community problems, and we are doing our best to help solve them."

- on the industry outlook - "I am optimistic about the future of our industry. The short-term progress of the industry is tied in with the general North American economy, and I can see glimmerings of an economic upturn."
