

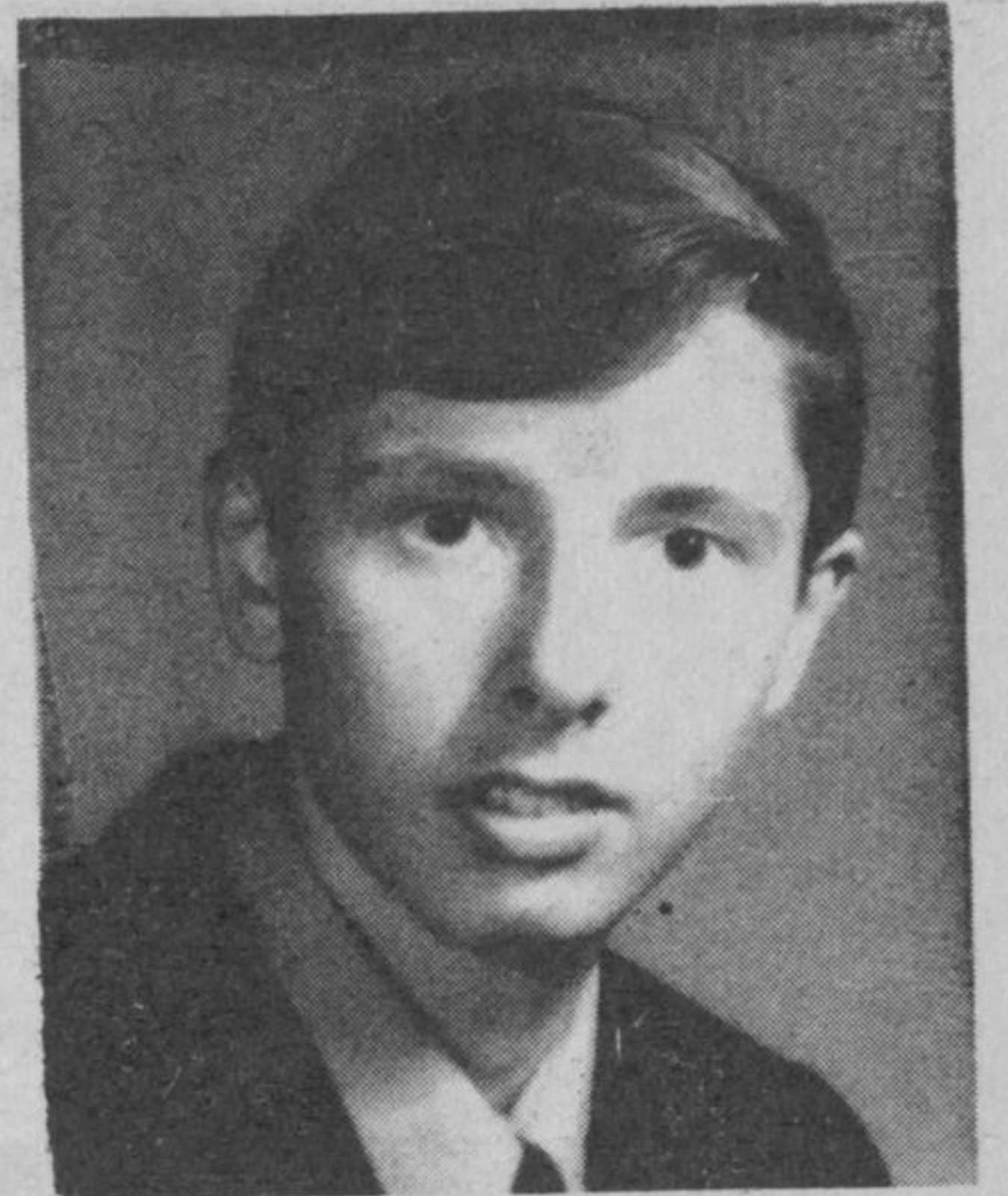
**BILL SMILSKY COMPETES IN ONTARIO FINALS**

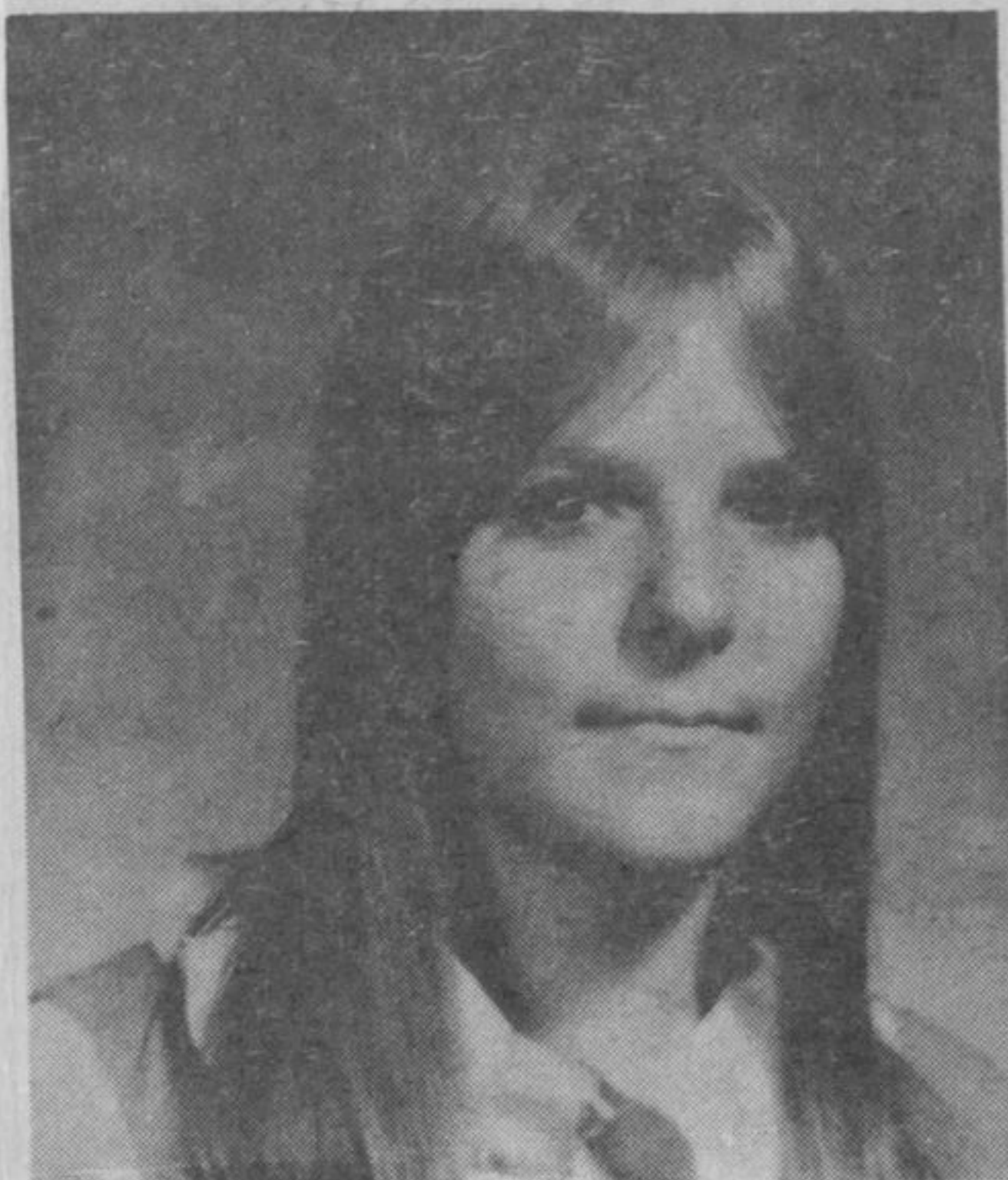

The grant in the amount of \$6,700.45 and the advice and assistance of Mr. Starr and his staff contributed immensely to the success of this project.

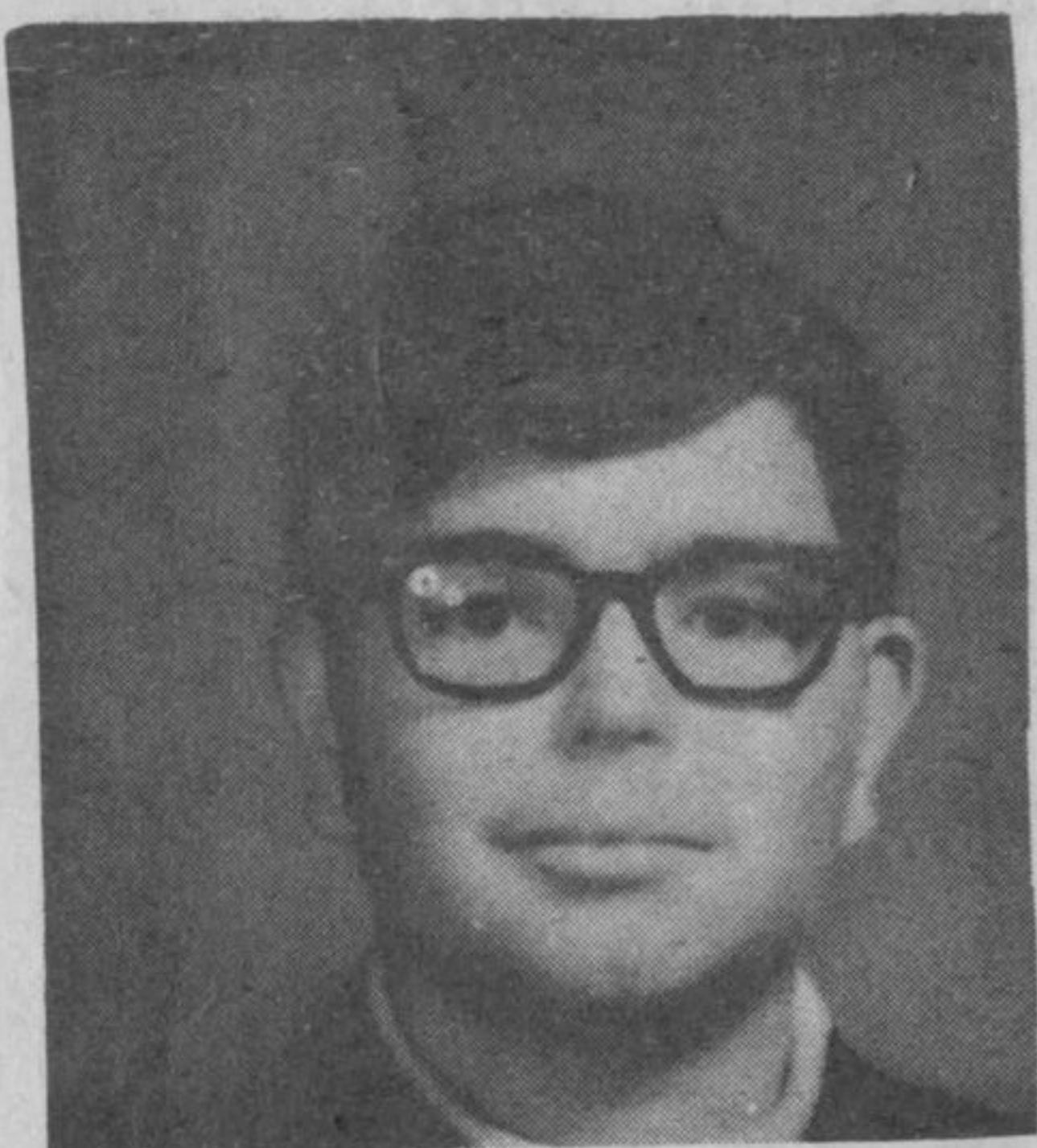
The close co-operation of teachers, students, businessmen and the Schreiber Municipal Council made this undertaking a reality and they are to be commended for a job well done."
