The full spectrum of services will be available on a toll-free telephone number which will be used to send telegrams, order travel tickets on trains, planes or ships, obtain freight rate information, order freight cars for local industries or obtain advance information on carload consignments.

The decision to open a centre on the Schreiber Division was taken after detailed study of traffic, operations and facilities on the division's 552.8 miles of rail line.

The new system will involve withdrawal of staff from some local stations but protective measures are provided for all affected employees under a special agreement with the unions concerned. These measures have been designed to minimize the impact of the changes on employees.

L.A. HOLD FINAL SEASON MEETING

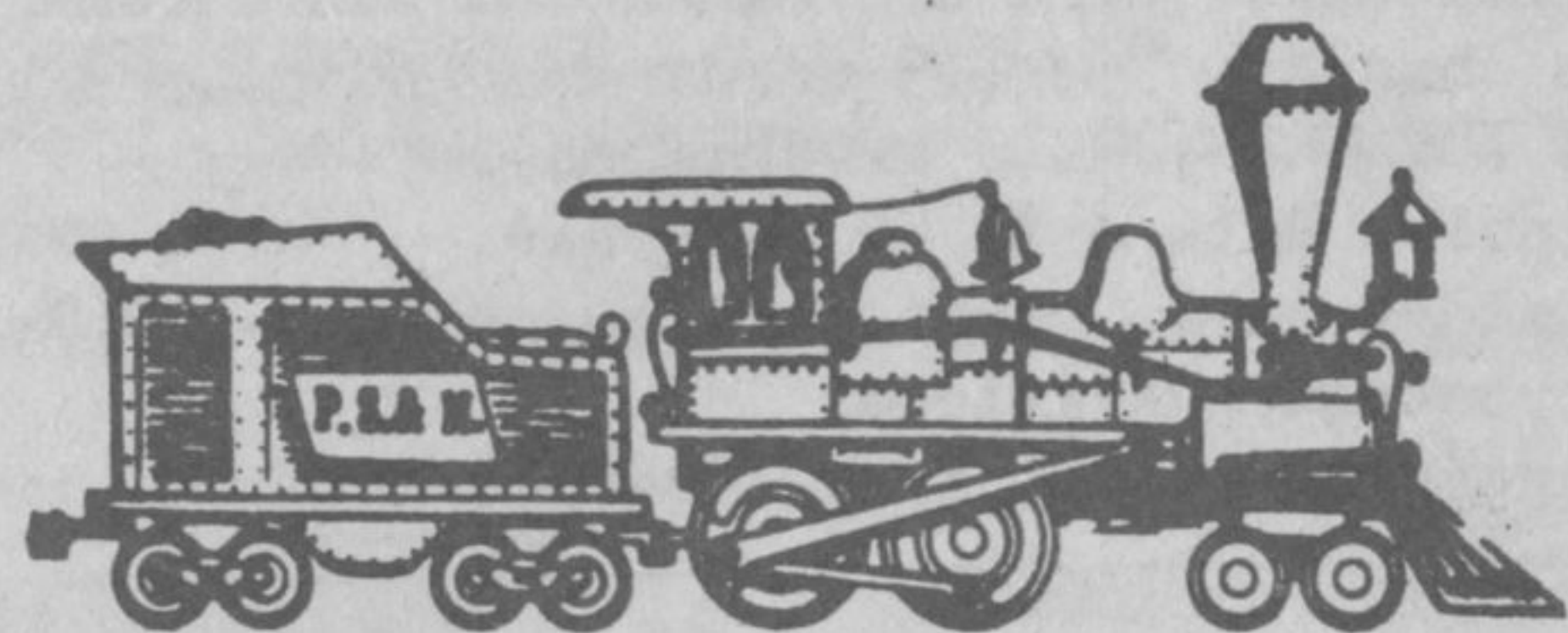
