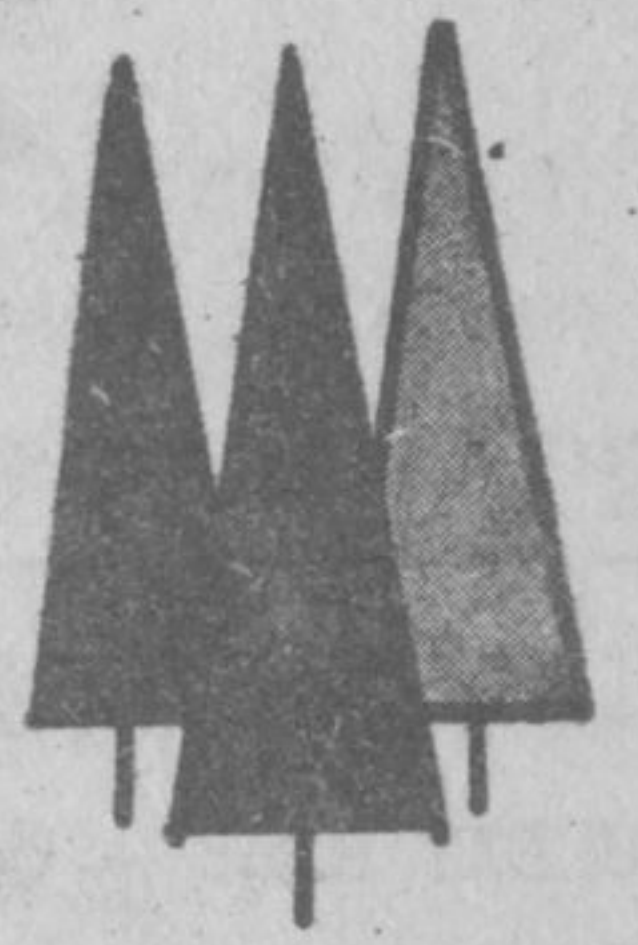

ATTENDANCE AT AWARDS NIGHT OUTSTANDING

Close to 300 people attended the Awards Night which took place at the High School Auditorium last Thursday, August 12th.

It was extremely encouraging to see the number of parents that attended this special programme for the children who took part in all summer activities. During the course of the evening, the Playground children as directed by the Playground staff presented some very interesting entertainment and it was certainly enjoyed by those in attendance.

The presentation of the Duriez Trophy to the winner was one of the highlights of the evening. Winners of this year's Duriez Trophy were R. Vanderkam and A. Vanderkam. This trophy is presented annually by Mr. and Mrs. H. Duriez, based on seven different categories on which swimmers are judged. These two boys should be extremely proud of winning this award as the trophy is emblematic of swimmers who are having a very successful year at both the competitive swimming level and the training level.

For the first time since the trophy has been awarded, independent judging which takes place among eight people resulted in a tie.
