

DEPT. OF EDUCATION PROGRAM WELL ATTENDED

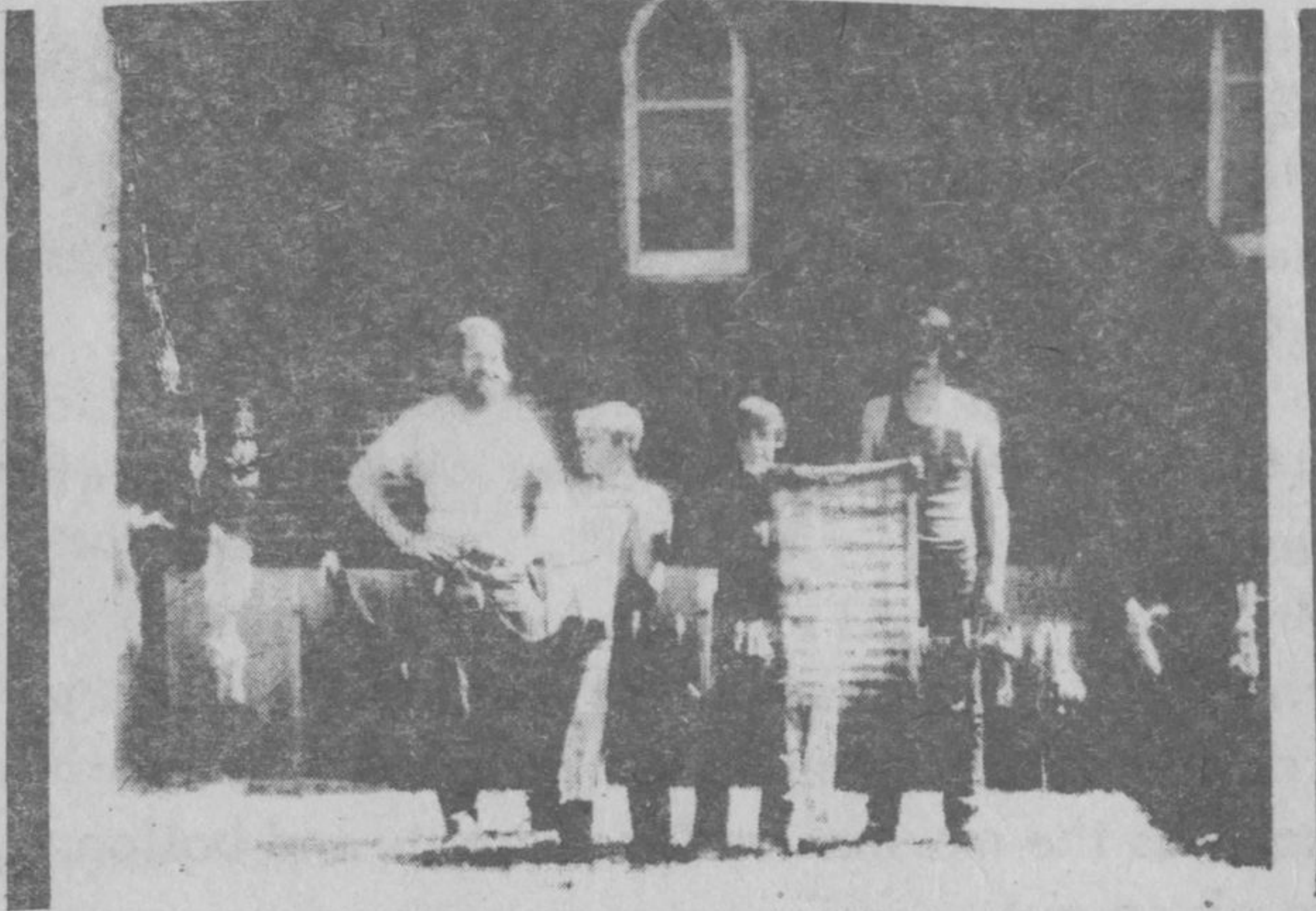
Bruce Greenop and Denis Cliff, of the Department of Education, Youth and Recreation, spent three lively days with a class of thirty-five interested children in Schreiber, capturing their attention with illustrations and showing them, at the roots, the principles of sketching, staining, acrylic painting, batik, tie-dying, silk screening, ink drawing, water colors and pastels. The class increased from a curious few to thirty-five steady attendants.

The bus which they travel in has had several interesting paintings - the work of the students in Gravenhurst, Marathon, and Schreiber and it is expected in Thunder Bay and Kenora.

The paint is washable so each town begins with its own concept.

In Schreiber the meetings were held in the Anglican Church with a large, entertained crowd gathering to inspect the tied-and-dyed exhibits strung on a clothesline to dry.
