**LETTER TO THE EDITOR**

I would like to ask, through your local paper, for the co-operation of citizens regarding the pictographs which are located at Worthington Bay, south of Schreiber and recently re-discovered.

These pictographs are rare, very old and irreplaceable. The Royal Ontario Museum and their associate Dr. Dewdney believe they pre-date the white man in Canada. It is apparent there is being some mutilation of these markings by persons touching or scraping the surface. If this were continued the pictographs would gradually disappear, and this area would lose one of its real historical links. So may I suggest that they be viewed and photographed only.

The owners of the property and the Government have not seen fit to safeguard these pictographs and so I ask local help in protecting them until further investigation of their worth has been established.
