the three main priorities for the next few months are: (1) Establishment of administrative policies and systems according to public hospital standards (2) Study of statistical data from the Ontario Hospital Services Commission on hospital bed needs and (3) Preparation for the first Annual Meeting and election of Board Members (March, 1972).
