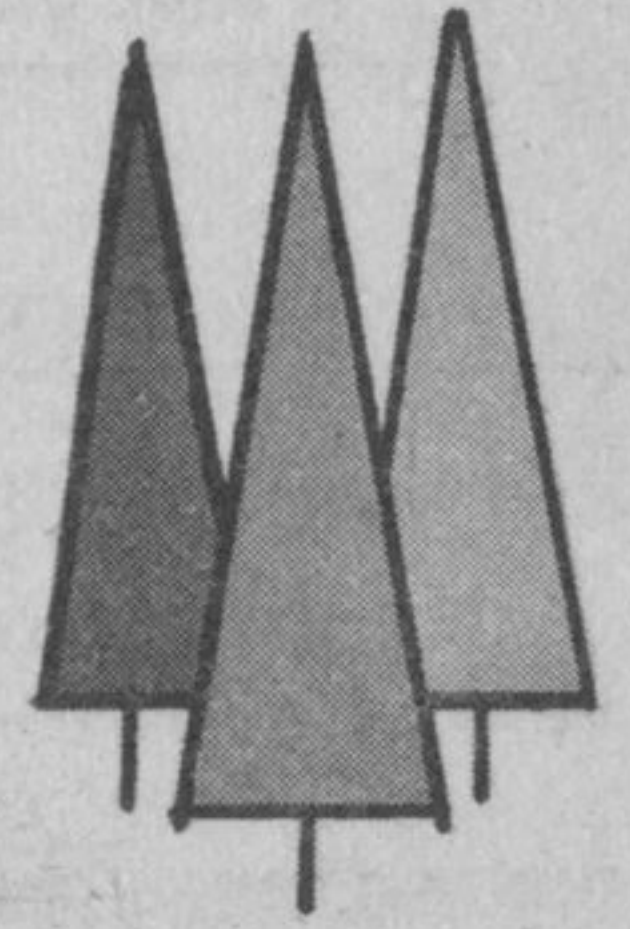

The Girl Guide Division Commissioner for Terrace Bay, Mrs. George Caron, was honoured by the Girl Scout Council of St. Croix Valley at the Council's annual meeting on January 25th. She was awarded a Certificate of Appreciation by the Girl Scout Council, which has its headquarters in St. Paul, Minnesota.

Last summer an international Girl Scout-Girl Guide event, the Lake Superior Hike, was climaxed by a rendezvous celebration on the beach at Terrace Bay. Mrs. Caron was active in making the three day rendezvous for seventy-seven American Senior Girl Scouts and Canadian Girl Rangers a success.
