There were also many friends from Terrace Bay who came to lend willing hands.

The food booth still continues, its equipment continually being improved, and a much enjoyed adjunct for the fans attending hockey games. And, the number and enthusiasm of Schreiber fans, whose reputation is well known in the district, require food, to replenish the vigour they expend at the games.
