Over 34,000 articles of clothing and bedding are made each year by volunteers of the Canadian Red Cross Women's Work Committee for distribution to disaster stricken Canadians. These volunteers also make some seven and one half million dressings each year for the Canadian Red Cross Blood Transfusion Service.

Volunteers of the Red Cross Women's Work Committee annually provide hundreds of thousands of people in need worldwide with clothing. Last year more than 436,000 articles of clothing for relief in emergencies were made by these volunteers and shipped all over the world.

In more than 500 communities across Canada the Sickroom Equipment Loan Service of the Canadian Red Cross provides persons with the equipment they require free of charge. Each year the Sickroom Equipment Loan Service plays an ever increasing role in community assistance. Wheel chairs, hospital beds, crutches, canes, bed tables are only a few of the items available on loan.
