WESTERN ONTARIO

The department of lands and forests is conducting a telephone survey about cottaging in selected communities of Northwestern Ontario.

The main objectives of the survey in Thunder Bay, Kenora, Fort Frances, Dryden, Atikokan, Terrace Bay, Schreiber, Wawa, and Sioux Lookout, are to determine local demand for cottage lots and to identfy the preferences and characteristics of both owners and non-owners of summer cottages.
