



Goway asks agents to join young travel revolution

Goway Travel Advisors, which has specialized in the youth travel market in Canada, is now going after business from the retail agent.

The company, which is located at 53 Yonge St., Toronto 1, is offering camping tours through Europe, Russia and North Africa.

Goway represents Transit Travel of London, England and offers five basic European-Russian camping trips ranging in length from five weeks to 14 weeks.

"Often the retail agent doesn't have anything to offer the young traveller on a budget," said Bruce Hodge of Goway. The company is sending out flyers to agents asking them to join the "young travel revolution."

A sample trip is a nine-week Central European holiday which visits England, France, Andorra, Spain, Monaco, Italy, Greece, Turkey, Bulgaria, Yugoslavia, Hungary, Austria, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, Germany, Holland and Belgium and costs \$581 including food, visas and insurance.

Sundowners also offers a 23-day tour to Russia, Poland and Finland ex London for \$222.50 including food plus air fare. A 38-day northern and eastern-Europe package is \$330 including food.
