registering official of an eligible institution, that the student is enrolled.

Should a student selected for an award fail to enroll in an institution of higher learning under the conditions outlined above, then the award shall be forfeited. The award will be made available to another eligible student at the discretion of the Trustees.

If there are no eligible students for the award in any school year, then the Trustees may consider granting the award to former students of Terrace Bay, Schreiber and Rossport who are already in attendance at an institute of higher learning and are in need of financial aid to continue their education.

Applications may be obtained from the Terrace Bay High School and the Schreiber High School. Upon completion, applications must be forwarded to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Trust, Mr. T.S. Pollard, Box 1, Terrace Bay, Ontario.
