Some major repair work will be done on the fencing in the near future; however, the courts are presently in playable shape.

When using the courts, be sure to:

- (1) take extra care of the line tapes
- (2) use the waste container provided
- (3) report any damage to the Recreation Office
- (4) lock the courts when you leave

If tennis players do not co-operate in using the courts, then the Recreation Office will have no choice but to revert to a more restrictive system which will be an inconvenience to tennis players.
