

The Schreiber Municipal Council, at their regular June meeting, received word from Jack Stokes, MPP, that the Honourable Ross MacDonald, Lieut. Governor, will be touring Thunder Bay Riding on

October 10,11, and 12th and it was unanimously agreed to co-operate with Terrace Bay in any arrangements to accommodate Mr. MacDonald while he is in this area.

F. Wright, inspector, Waste Management Branch, Dept. of the Environment, is to be contacted regarding proposals for the collection, dumping of solid waste, and maintenance of land fill site.

Request for a water serivce to a new home on Hill view Street was granted.
