As a result of a study conducted by Ontario Hydro, relative to Hydro rates in Terrace Bay, a submission was received which would indicate an increase in Hydro rates to Terrace Bay consumers of approximately 12%. Approval will be sought from the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario to adopt new rates effective on all bills issues on and after October 1, 1972. All indications are that a further adjustment will be required in the latter part of 1973.

The Police Report read in part - three car accidents were inves-


tigated. Two magazine sellers were asked to leave town for selling without a license.
