### Terrace Bay Swim Team to Compete in Northwestern Ontario Championships:

The Terrace Bay swim team will be travelling to Thunder Bay this coming Saturday, August 26th, to compete in the annual Northwestern Ontario Swimming Championships. The meet will be held at the Widdall Pool in Thunder Bay and will get underway at 9:30 a.m. It is important to note that two summers ago the Terrace Bay swim team won their division in the Northwestern Ontario championships. We are hopeful that our swim team will put in their best effort at the meet.

### Final Swim Tests:

All swimmers will be notified by their respective instructors this week as to the day and time of their tests.
