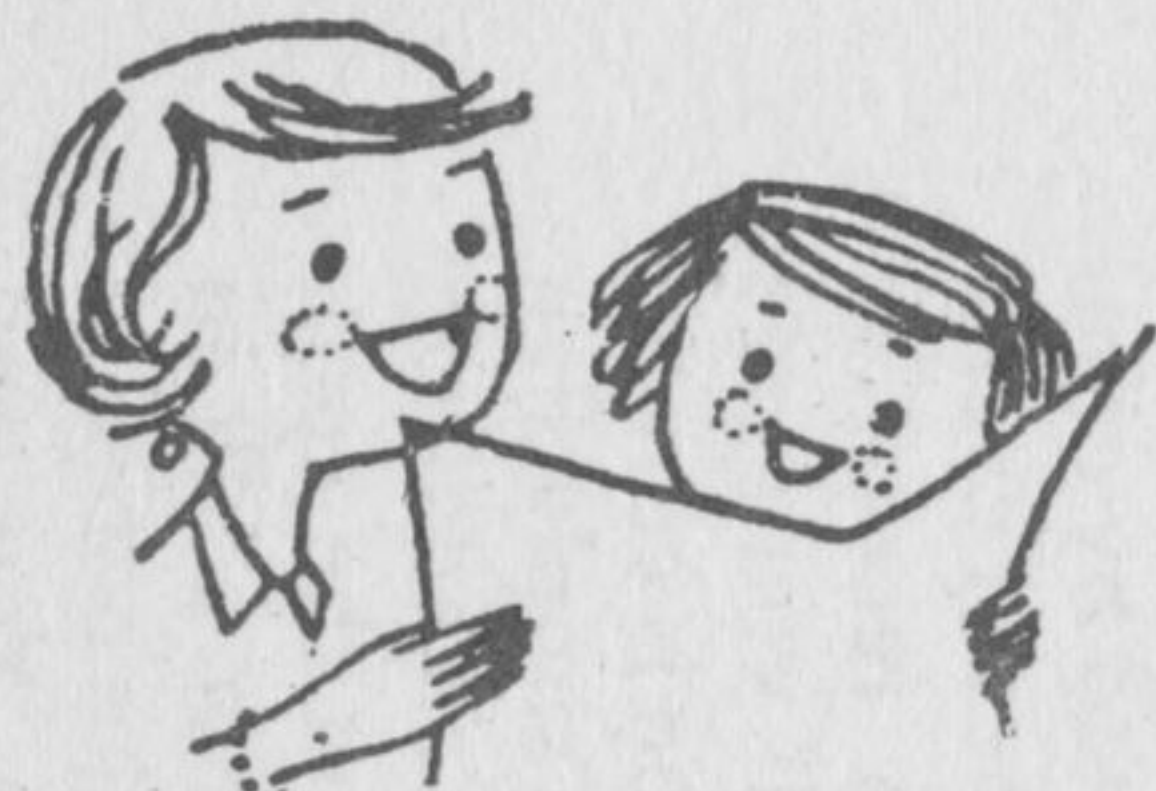


TERRACE BAY
