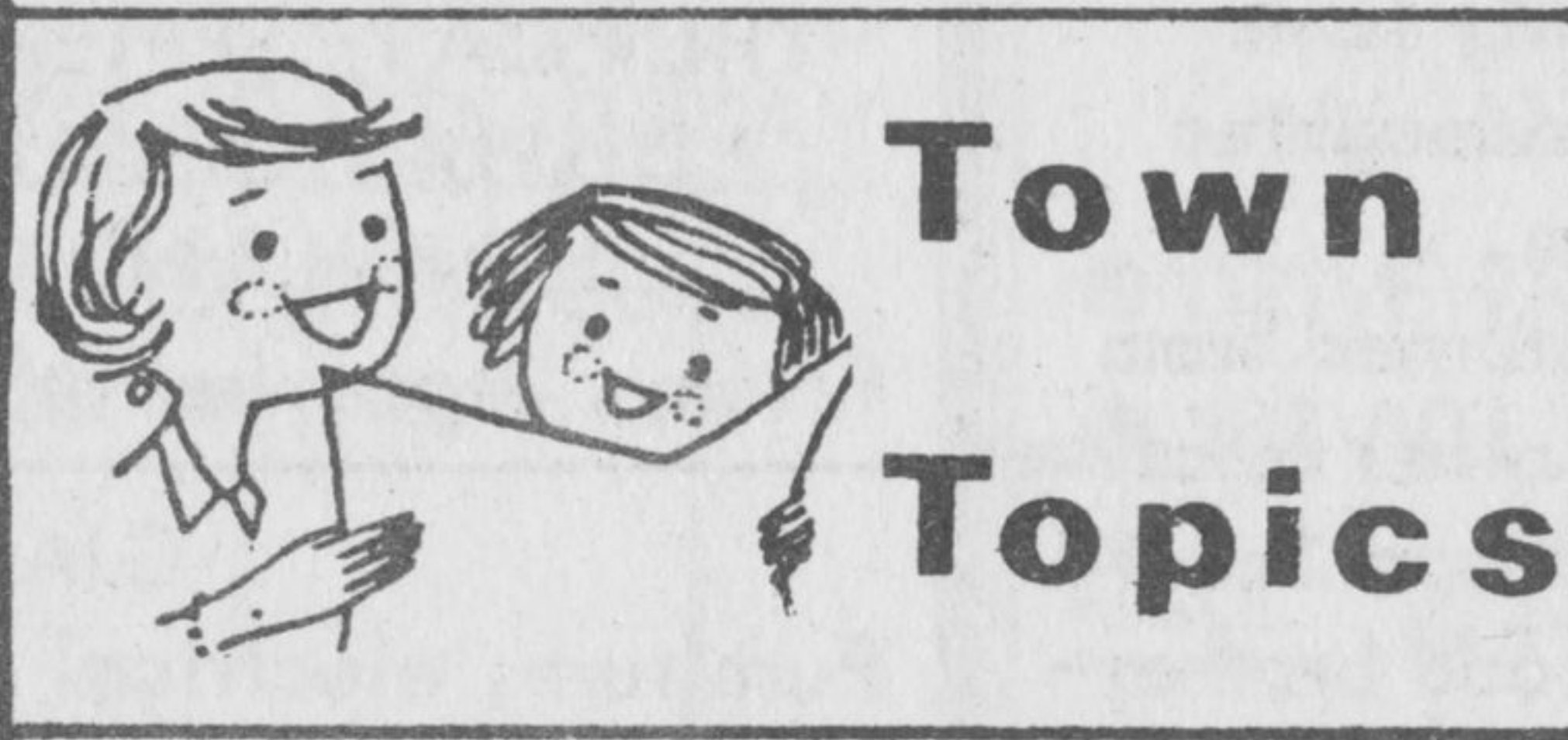


ROSSPORT
