ly does not exist in the area for maintenance of aircraft owned by other air transport operations.

Pass Lake Lumber, located at Pass Lake, will receive \$23,265 to build and equip a woodworking shop for the prefabricate of components used in housing construction and remodeling. The new business will serve the local cottage and farming community.

Sawmill operator Vernon L. Shortreed will increase production in his Fort Frances mill as a result of an \$18,480 loan to help purchase new equipment which will provide more efficient movement of raw and finished materials.

Northland Trailers (Soo) Limited, a supplier of mobile homes and industrial camp buildings to industries and communities in Northern Ontario will receive \$106,125. The Sault Ste. Marie company will add 24,000 square feet of manufacturing space and purchase additional equipment for the production of "double-wide" houses up to 50 feet by 22 feet in size. This type of housing is now being obtained in

other areas and transported into Northern Ontario for delivery to purchasers.

Increased employment will be created by the new and expanded facilities as a result of the NODC loans. It is expected that the four companies receiving loans will provide almost sixty new jobs in the northwestern area of the province over the next five years.
