shall permit an unlicensed driver to operate it on a highway.

- 4. No person shall drive a snow vehicle on a high-way unless he is insured under a motor vehicle liability policy.
- 5. Accidents involving injury or damage to the property of any person other than the owner, which is over \$200.00, shall be reported forthwith to the nearest Provincial or Municipal police officer.
- 6. The driver of a snow vehicle shall obey all the official directions of signs as defined in the Highway Traffic Act.
- 7. The driver of snow vehicle about to enter or cross a roadway from adjoining property shall stop before entering the roadway.
- 8. The operator of a snow vehicle approaching a railway shall bring the machine to a stop and shall not proceed across until it is safe to do so.
- 9. Every person is guilty of careless driving who drives a snow vehicle without due care and attention and without reasonable consideration for other persons
- 10. When being operated on a highway one half hour after sunset to one half hour before sunrise and at any time when other vehicles and persons cannot be clearly seen at a distance of 500 feet or less, ever every snow vehicle shall show to the front one white or amber light and to the rear, one red light.
