half-time teacher at the Lake Superior High School, effective January 1, 1973; Mrs. Mary Kideres, Marathon Public School as a teacher for the period January 1, 1973 to June 30, 1973 inclusive; Mrs. Joyce Bishop as an occasional teacher at Manitouwadge Public School for the period January 1, 1973 to June 30, 1973 inclusive (maternity leave replacement) at salary according to schedule; Mr. Anthony E. Boodhoo, English teacher at the Lake Superior High School, effective January 1, 1973.

The Board approved the appointment of Mr. Simon Cormier as a probationary employee on the maintenance staff of the Lake Superior High School for a three month period commencing January 2, 1973.
