acknowledged the appointment of Councillor N. A. McCuaig to the Liason with Council committee.

Notice was received of the Ontario Municipal Recreation Association Northwestern Ontario conference being held in Thunder Bay April 6-8.

Notice was also received that an Advisory Task Force on Housing Policy has been established by the government and will hold meetings with municipal representatives in various areas in Thunder Bay March 2-3.

The Ministry of Treasury, Economics and Intergovernmental Affairs advised Schreiber had been granted an additional \$2,000 re Provincial-Municipal Employment incentive program

The resolution of the town of Thorold concerning exceptions to the Task Force Hydro Recommendation was endorsed.

A letter from a citizen expressed concern over the traffic hazard at Subway and Winnipeg Streets and council decided to instal a guard rail at the corner as soon as weather permits.

In response to a request for a donation from a well-known and admired charitable institution council replies that since a door to door canvas is made annually it does not feel a second contribution should be given.

The Fire Department budget of approximately \$8,000 was approved.

A letter of appreciation was received from

the public library board for council's interest and support, and the excellent condition in which their premises were maintained.

The Ministry of Transportation and Communications advised that an estimated cost of improving the juncture of Walker Lake Road and Drummond Street would be \$27,000 and the proposal was filed.

The Reeve reported contacting the Department of Health in Toronto for assistance in securing a replacement for Dr. Wykes and was told Dr. Copeman will come to Schreiber to assess the situation.

Council has sent a letter to McCausland Hospital Board requesting equal privileges for a Schreiber doctor.

The members were in favour of forming a cemetery board.

The property committee were asked to look into the matter of parking facilities for town employees at the town hall, and the sale of the old scale house.

Water works accounts of \$667.66 and general accounts of \$1,636.51 were passed for payment.

Council noted with appreciation the recent gift of a stethoscope and blood pressure clamp to the Schreiber ambulance by the local Kinsmen, who donated the town's first ambulance
