projects fund and council decided to present ideas which will enable Schreiber to participate in the program.

General accounts of \$630.04 were passed for payment.

A grant of \$2,000.00, based on assessment, was approved to assist the McCausland Hospital with its 1972 deficit.

A highlight of the meeting was the report submitted by Kim Krause, representing a committee of four students, for a summer works project maintaining the cemetery and landscaping the new one. For students of that age Council concurred it was of a masterly presentation of facts; hours of work expected, price of equipment which will be required for certain labour, cost of lumber and paint for present and new required fencing, and a map showing the actual area of the grounds. In an aside, which delighted the said councillors, the young speaker, suggested several ways, whereby in quick action they might save some money on the project! In turn, council questioned the necessity of renting a post hole digger - where these young fellows unable to dig? Kim replied "They had ordered them-but Eaton's has discontinued that line". Council of course unanimously supported Operation Cemetery. And pleased with the conclusion of the

brief which suggested that what people prize is what they own, by working for it, and, maybe, since the proper respect for a cemetery comes from understanding it is a tribute to ones who live in the town and built it, young people may acquire a different attitude toward it, particularly since their age group are involved in its preservation.

It was decided to purchase insurance for the Reeve and Councillors.

Permission was granted to a town employee to assist Schreiber Hydro providing the time when he will be required does not interfere with his normal duties.
