Tom Jones and Sons advised they can offer design-built proposals for any municipal projects and council will ask for design drawings for building approximately 2500 by 3000 square feet for proposed medical centre.

Permission was granted to sell tickets in Schreiber for the Nipigon Legion Fall Fishing Festival.

Complains from citizens, in which council concurred, concerned cars racing the streets at night and the deplorable condition of the ravine in the centre of the town. This will be cleaned and further dumping strictly prohibited.

Councillor N.A. McCuaig was asked to secure estimate of cost of survey for new landfill site.

Steps will be taken to prevent the dumping of garbage in pit on Langworthy Street.

Water works accounts of \$116.23 and general accounts of \$1315.59 were passed for payment.

The drainage problem at Drummond and Walker Lake Road will be studied.

In response to request a little container will be placed in the vicinity of the public school.
