PROCESSED ORGANIC WASTE DISPOSAL REGULATIONS

Ontario recently introduced new regulations covering the disposal of processed organic wastes, Environment Minister James Auld reported.

This regulation deals with the application of these sludges on land, specifying the amounts that can be applied to various types of soil, during which months of the year, and in what amounts based on a scale of equivalent pounds of nitrogen per year per acre.

Contractors who deal in these sludges will have to obtain a Certificate of Approval through the Ministry's Waste Management Branch to operate a hauling system. Approval certificates will also have to be obtained for the various disposal sites. Complete records of the types and volumes of these processed organic wastes applied at each site will have to be kept and these records communicated to the Ministry's Waste Management Branch every month.

"Expanded programs of nutrient removal in pollution control plants will increase the volumes of sludge that will have to be disposed of." "This future increase in volume is one reason for the establishment of this program," Mr. Auld said.

**USE OF SANITARY LAND FILL SITE
TOWNSHIP OF TERRACE BAY**

To comply with the standards established by the Waste Management Branch of The Ministry of Environment, it is necessary to implement changes affecting the use of our Land Fill Site. Effective date for the following changes will be July 2, 1973.

- (1) To provide proper covering and compaction the site will be open during specified periods only:

<u>OPEN</u>	<u>CLOSED</u>
MONDAYS 8 A.M. to	TUESDAY 4 P.M.
THURSDAYS 8 A.M. to	FRIDAY 4 P.M.

- (2) Persons using the site during the above periods must ensure that their refuse is placed over the bank in the pit area provided.
- (3) Garbage will continue to be picked up on Tuesdays and Fridays. This will apply to both residential and commercial premises.
