The atmosphere will be one of an enjoyable family afternoon. Food will be available at minimable cost and the open area of the plaza with the Terrace Bay Band in attendance should certainly highlight the day.

At most activities no entry fees will be charged and dance admissions will be as low as possible.

Hand flags will be available for children and all are invited to join in the fun.
