

**THE LAKE SUPERIOR BOARD OF EDUCATION
SCHOOL YEAR CALENDAR 1973-1974
for
ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS
IN TERRACE BAY AND SCHREIBER**

The Lake Superior Board of Education has accepted the Ministry of Education's guidelines for a 185 day school year for students. Teachers will maintain their present 197 day school year. The non-teaching days will be used by teachers for reporting to parents, interviews, curriculum development, professional development, workshops, statistical reports and planning.

In September, school officially opens on Tuesday, September 4th. The first day is a full school day. The following are non-teaching days at school:

- Oct. 8 - Thanksgiving
- Oct. 19 - Professional Development Day for High School Teachers only.
- Dec. 10 - Afternoon only in elementary schools for parent-teacher interviews and distribution of First Progress Report.
- Dec. 22 - Christmas holidays - Teachers will be working in the schools on curriculum development on January 3 and 4. Students return to school on January 7

- Jan. 30, 31, - Curriculum development involving teachers from Kindergarten & Feb. 1 to grade I3.
- Feb. 4 - Students return to school, Monday, February 4.
- Mar. 11 - Afternoon only for elementary schools, for parent-teacher interviews and distribution of Second Progress Report.
- Mar. 16 - Winter Holidays - Students return on March 25th

- April 12 - Good Friday
- April 14 - Easter Monday
- One day in April will be an Elementary School Professional Development Day.

The last school day for both elementary and secondary schools will be Friday, June 21, 1974.
