Mar. 16 - Winter Holidays - Students return on March 25th

April I4 - Easter Monday

One day in April will be an Elementary School Professional Development Day.

May 20 - Victoria Day.

The last school day for both elementary and secondary schools will be Friday, June 2I, 1974.
