theatre set in the ruins of the Ancient Baths of Rome, near the Caliseum.

From Rome their tour took them to Florence, where they viewed several famous old Churches, the National Art Gallery, with the famous status of David by Michael Angelo. On to Venice, where they stayed at a hotel on the Grand Canal and visited St. Mark's Square.

Leaving Italy they toured to Innsbruck, Austria, through the Brennar Pass in the Alps. They were hosted here at a student house where some of the people remembered them from their 1967 trip. Some of the members travelled up the mountain slopes by a funicular, a type of cable car, which took them up by three stages to where the good skiing takes place.

They travelled on to Salzburg, where it was pointed out to them, the sets for the picture "The Sound of Music" were taken. Here they saw, too, where Mozart had lived.

Their last stop was Munich, where on a sight-seeing trip they saw the Nymphenburg Schloss Palace, the summer home of Kings, The Glockenspiel in the City Hall and had a Gourmet Dinner at Hofbrauhaus.

The choir sang in a beer garden here, to the delight of the German orchestra and the patrons.

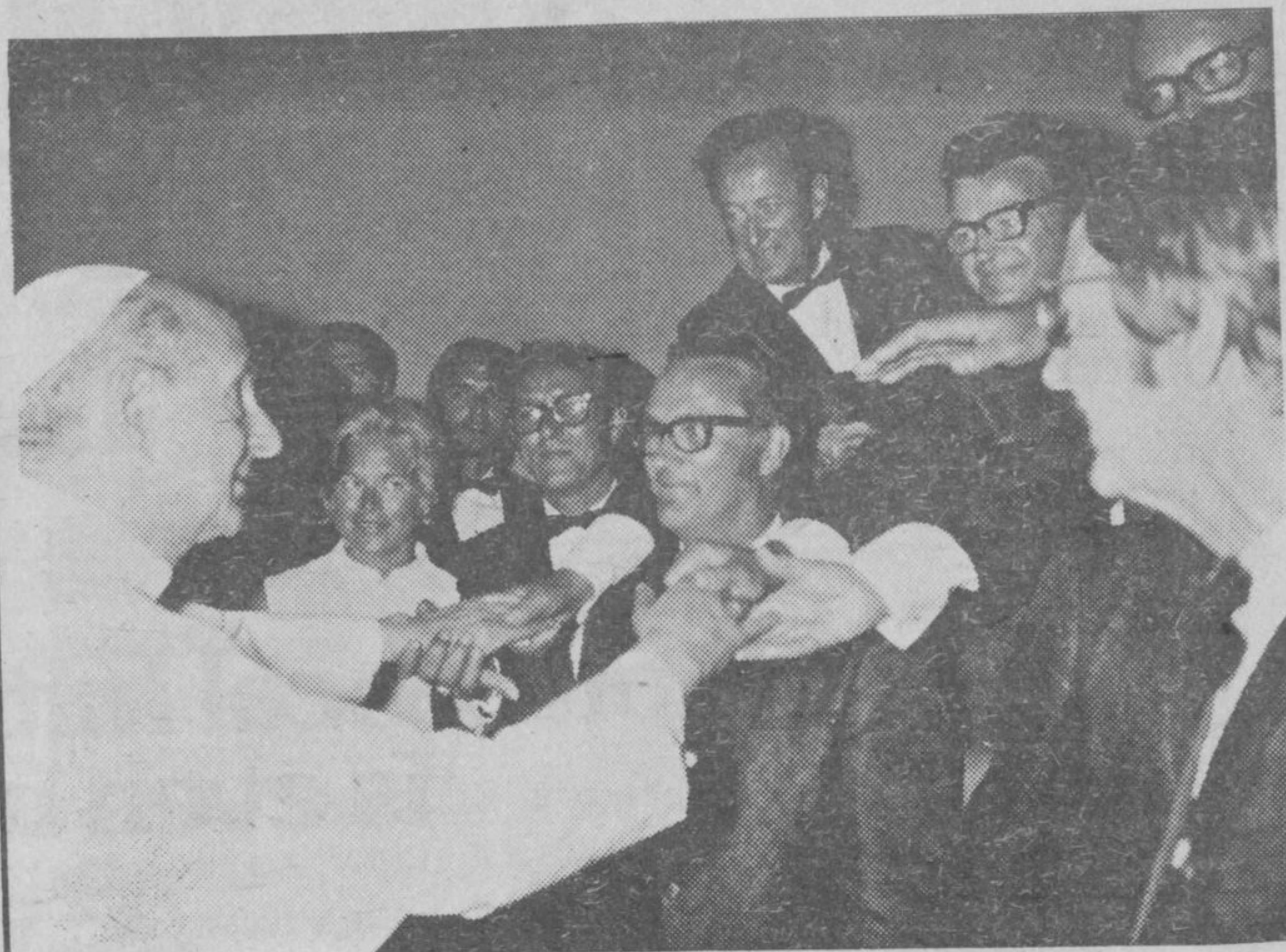
The choir and other guests were away a total of 23 days, bringing back souvenirs and many happy memories.

CHILDREN'S VISITING AT HOSPITAL

The McCausland Hospital Board passed the following resolution at its August meeting:

"that effective September 1, 1973 it is the policy of this hospital to have Visiting Hours in the Children's Ward from 3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. All other present visiting regulations will also apply to the children's ward"

This decision was taken upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee after consultation with the Chief of Medical Staff, Director of Nursing and Administrator. Because our present facility, has not been designed or staffed with the idea in mind of a separate active Children's Ward such as those in the larger hospitals of Thunder Bay, the hospital staff will need the co-operation and assistance of the public.
