The committee also agreed that the opinions and suggestions of the general public should be obtained. The Auxiliary to the hospital has already invited the committee to send a representative to speak at their October 15th meeting. Open public meetings will also be held in the future in order to answer questions and receive written briefs from individuals who wish to express their views in a more formal way.

Hospital employees will also be invited to express their views regarding improvements to the present hospital at an employee meeting scheduled for October 1, 1973. Frank Anderson, representing the Development Committee, will join in the discussions at this meeting.

The Development Committee will continue to place reports of their meetings in the newspaper and will make every attempt to keep everyone informed of their progress.

and the Terrace Bay Council, at which time the architect and engineers estimated the total project to be \$125,000, we have received tenders, and the lowest bid was \$249,000.

We did not re-negotiate the portion that the Hospital and the Township would be paying because of a number of factors. First, the time is very important. Secondly, we have been assured by the Ministry that the heating costs for the hotel would be borne by the Ministry. However, because of the total overall cost, the money that is available from the province for work in the Home is being restricted.
