Nora Perry as Early Childhood Education Assistant at Manitouwadge Public School, effective September 1, 1973, at salary according to schedule.

By-Law No. 22 was read a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd time and carried.

The Five Year Plan for Capital Expenditures as per Item B. 5. of the Agenda, with the established priorities as listed was carried.

The items classified as Major: Ordinary Expenditures are to be referred to the 1974 Budget Committee.

The Director is to investigate with Mr. MacLeod, Principal, matters of budget and hourly rate of pay.

The Board approved sketch plans No. 1, dated September 1973, for the addition to Marathon Public School, Stevens Avenue Campus, Job No. 7209.

An Ad Hoc Committee will be formed to research and recommend a policy regarding Interviews and Hiring, and that this Committee be composed of: One Elementary Principal, One Secondary Principal, the Director of Education and two Trustees.
