Ontario's Minister of Natural Resources, the Honourable Leo Bernier, has announced that the Ministry will hold mineral education classes in Schreiber from October 22 to 27th inclusive. Classes will be held each evening from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. in St. Andrew's United Church, 622 Winnipeg Avenue.

Mr. E.B. Freeman, geological lecturer of the Ministry, will conduct the course. Subjects to be covered include elementary geology, rock and mineral identification, prospecting methods, claim staking, assessment work regulations, and information sources. Mining films will be shown and mineral samples will be distributed free of charge. Books and other printed information will also be available.
