went to the Royal Ontario Museum, 88,000 learned about outer space in the McLaughlin Planetarium next door, 12,000 visited the Art Gallery of Ontario and 43,000 journeyed to Kleinburg to view the paintings by the Group of Seven in the McMichael Collection.

The visits must be tied in with a class's regular studies, and Mr. Wells said such visits should be particularly useful for courses in history, geography and social studies. The Ministry of Education will help arrange an itinerary for visiting classes.

Mr. Wells said the Ministry has allotted \$100,000 for the program during the 1973-74 school year. Subsidies will be granted on a first-come first-served basis.
