and Kodak High Speed Ektachrome film (Daylight) for color work are good choices.

Even with a fast film and a fast lens, it would be advisable to bracket your exposures. With the lens wide open, make exposures starting with one minute, and then cut the exposure in half (approximately) with each successive exposure until you reach 1/60 second. In this way you'll make about a dozen exposures, several of which may be acceptable. Since the comet will be visible for such a long time you'll have ample opportunity to choose the best exposure range and make additional photographs, if you wish.

Soon you'll have an extremely rare opportunity. Whether you photograph or just observe this unusual phenomenon, don't let it pass unnoticed. You won't have another chance for 80,000 years.
