
The general purpose of this educational program is to provide a short geological course with emphasis on common minerals and rock types, economic minerals, types of ore deposits, a review of recent developments in the mining industry, case historys of mine findings, the importance of the mining industry, etc.

It is also designed to instruct people on how to stake claims and the assessment work requirements of the Mining Act; give information regarding the services and publications of the Department, display identified specimens of rock and minerals, teach bush travel mapping and instrument techniques, handling of explosives and to contribute to an understanding of the world in which we live - the geological processes that have shaped it in the past and are shaping it in the present.


And, to maintain the traditions established in I894 by the first Provincial Geologist who spent much of his time giving lectures similar to those presented by Mr. Freeman and others.


