

**CBQ TO SERVE NORTHWESTERN ONTARIO**

CBQ is the call sign for the new CBC radio station located at 213 Miles Street, Thunder Bay.

CBQ will be taking over twelve repeaters in Northwestern Ontario including Terrace Bay and will be heard in both Terrace Bay and Schreiber beginning December 17th.

Three local newscasts will be heard in the morning and two in the afternoon in addition to national broadcastings.

The Station Manager is Mr. Doug Ward who will be managing a staff of sixteen, most of whom are from Northwestern Ontario.

The News Director, Mr. Frank Hilliard was in the Terrace Bay News Office last Friday giving us this information and he stated "CBQ hopes to act as a something in common between the separated communities of Northwestern Ontario so they know each other better."

Phone shows will also be heard which will have local personalities and people of interest on the air.

CBQ will be broadcasting from frequency 800 on your radio dial.

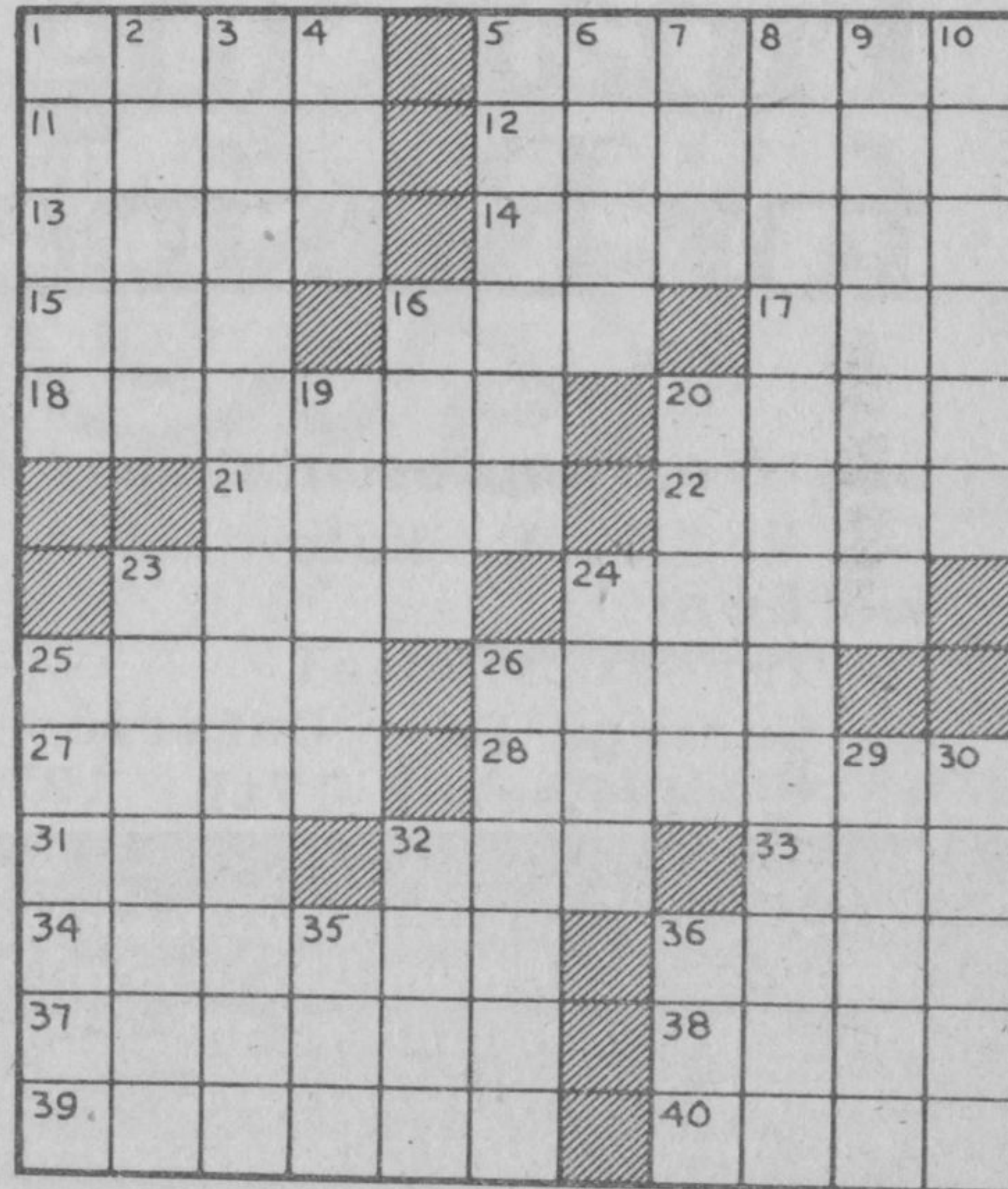
