Council endorsed the city of Sudbury's resolution that the Federal Government be petitioned, through local M.P.'s, to extend assistance to all Northern Ontario Municipalities under the D.R.E.E. program for sewage collection and disposal systems, similar to those extended to the Province of Quebec and the Maritimes, as well as certain municipalities in Ontario.

The purchase of 50 parking meters, to replace the present ones, was discussed but no decision made.

HOSPITAL BOARD MEETING

The McCausland Hospital Board of Governors held a regular meeting on November 20, 1973 in the Schreiber Municipal Office. Under business arising, Frank Anderson read the minutes of the last Development Committee meeting and reported that some members of the committee, will meet with certain health agencies in Thunder Bay. The committee then hopes to have a proposal ready for the full Board in the early part of 1974 and will recommend that Dr. Baldwin, Area Planning Co-Ordinator for the Ministry of Health, be invited to visit us again to discuss the proposal.

Don Beno read a report of the Finance Committee meeting with Mr. Herring, Financial Representative - Ministry of Health. Mr. Herring was unable to answer our questions regarding capital funding for new hospitals or availability of other funds or grants but did suggest that the Board contact Mr. Jamieson, Manager of Hospital Grants.

Bill Kirkpatrick reported that the Public Relations Committee will continue to place articles in the Terrace Bay News and will propose a date for the Annual Meeting at the December Board meeting.
