

### TERRACE BAY POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT

A total of seventeen occurrences were investigated by the Terrace Bay Police Department during the past week.

Mrs. W. Schelling hosted the St. Berchman's Alter Society Tuesday evening at their December meeting. Following the business part of

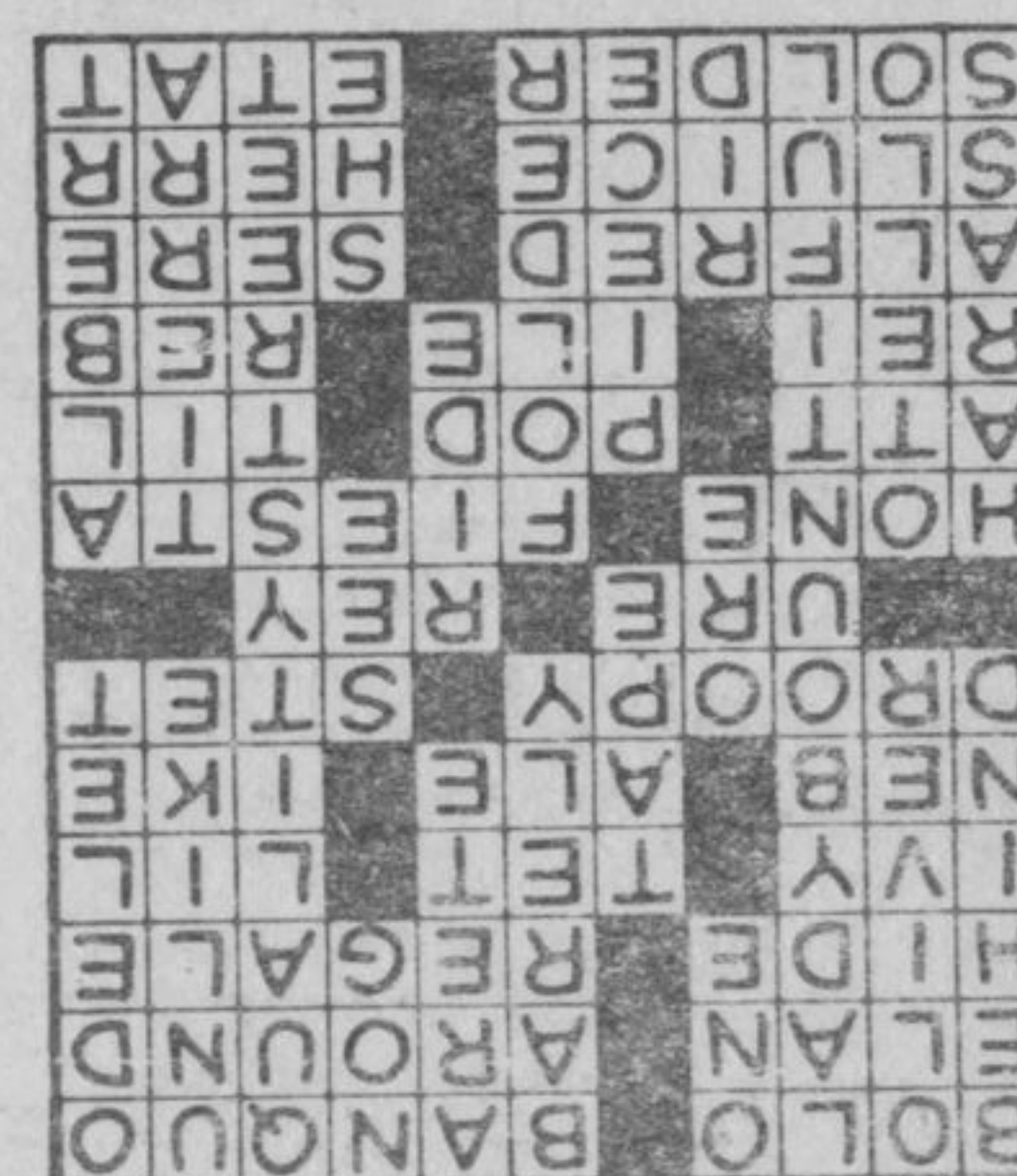
the organization a Christmas party was held with an exchange of gifts from a decorated tree and luncheon served from a table set in the Christmas theme.
