Father F.J. Meyer who gave the opening and closing prayers, thanked the members for their loyal support and the financial assistance they gave to their church and parish.

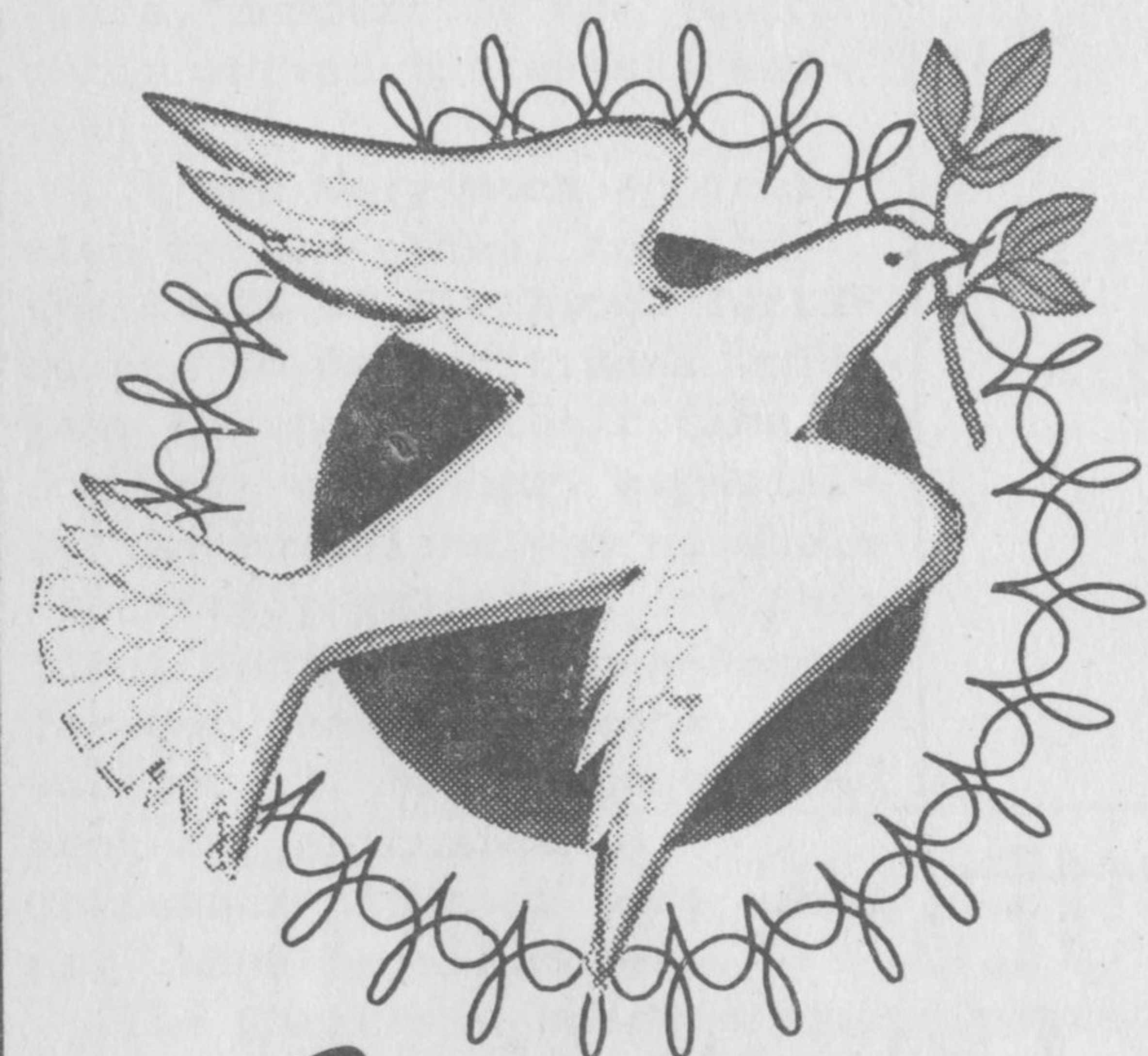
Following the meeting Sister Carol accompanied a round of carol singing and the 40 members present enjoyed lunch and a social hour.
