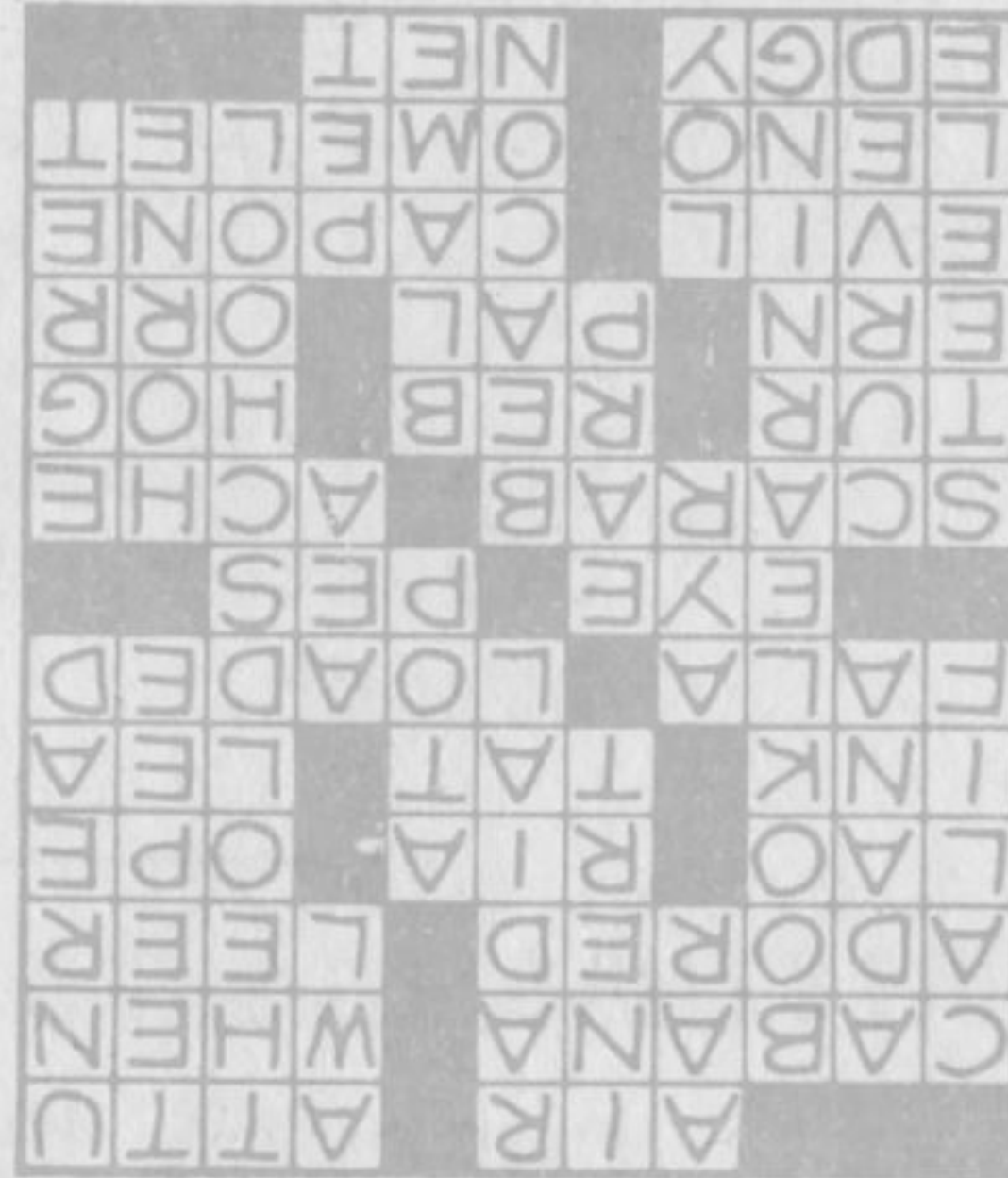


Broken Engagement

CROSSWORD PUZZLE

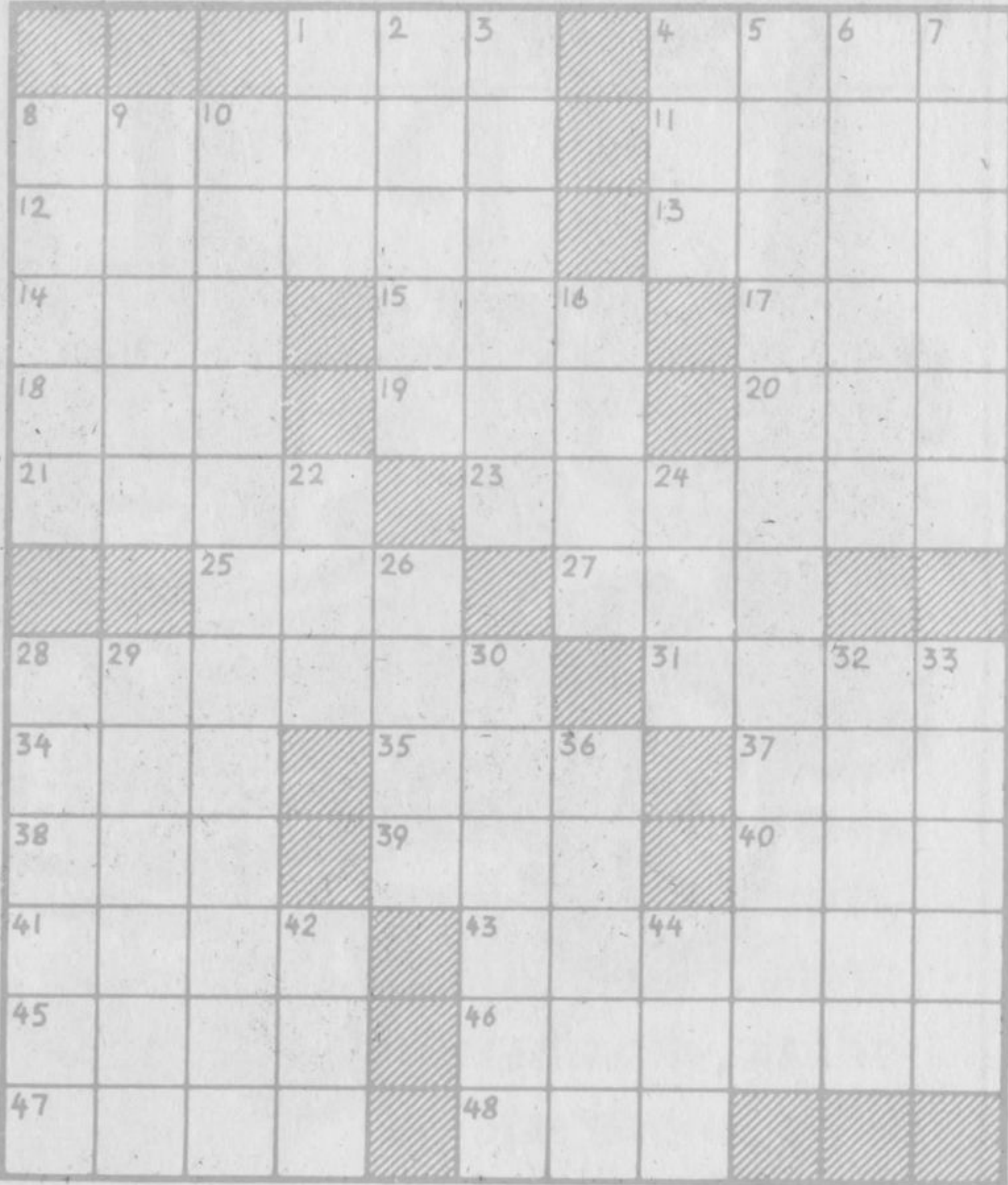

this season because of the energy crunch, Ontario Hydro's electrical inspection department issues its annual warning to check closely all such lights and to keep a sharp lookout for electrical appliances available as gifts.

"There is no question that the market is flooded this year, as is usual at Christmas, with shoddy, sub-standard and potentially dangerous lights and other appliances," a Hydro spokesman warned.

He said these appliances are sold as "bargains" throughout the year, but are specially noticeable in the period before the annual buying spree.

One of the most common complaints has to do with "mini" hair dryers. Some of these are sub-standard and definitely dangerous. A quick check can tell whether they carry the CSA label, indicating the appliance has the approval
