RECOMMENDATIONS OF SAFETY PATROL COMMITTEE

- approved Department of Transportation school crossing signs (present ones too small)
- more cross-walks, suitably painted, and some present ones repainted.
- improve intersections by Costa's. Winnipeg Street is much lower on the south side of Columbia Street right where cars have to stop for the stop sign, it should be brought up to grade.
- possibility of hiring adult crossing-guards, minimum 2, for corner of Scotia Street and Subway Street, and for the corner of Columbia Street and Winnipeg Street.
