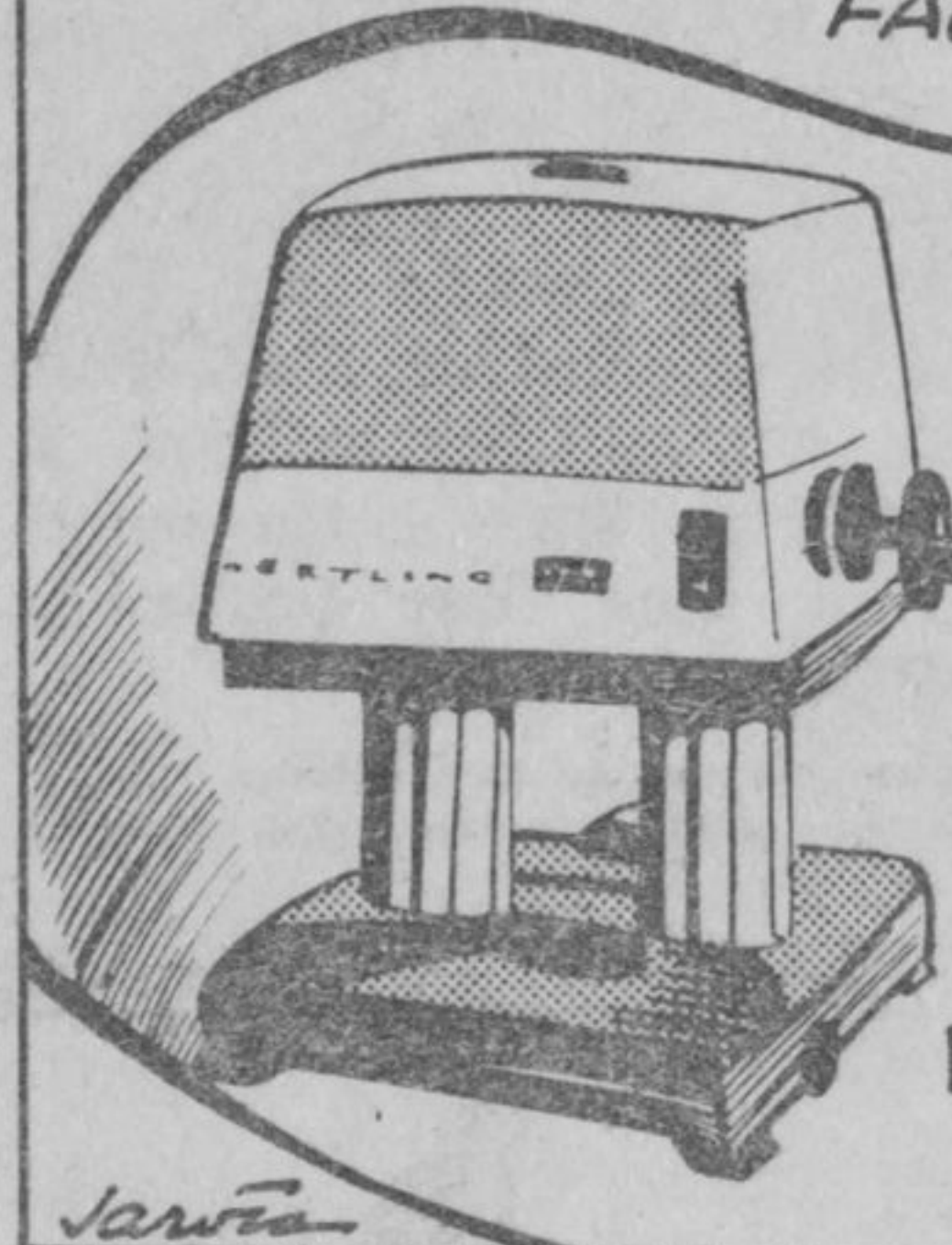


DID YOU KNOW?

Several novelty prizes were presented during the evening for various awards.

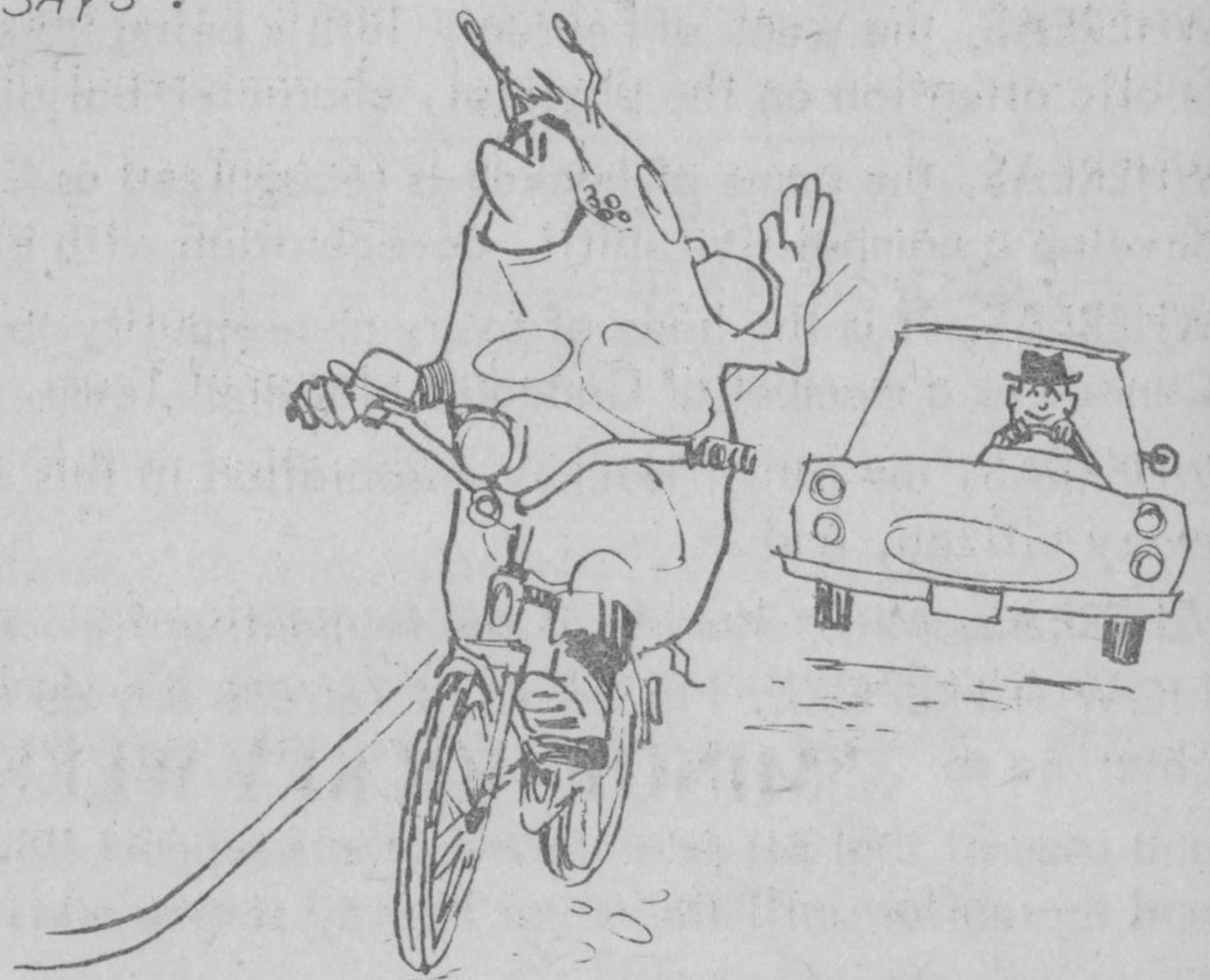
Winners of the spiel were: Clem Lemay, Steffie Dorman, D. Ramsay, and P. Deutscher.
