A. WHITNEY APPOINTED REGIONAL MANAGER



The Ministry of Transportation and Communications has announced the appointment of Arnott Allen Whitney to the position of Northwestern Regional Manager, Driver and Vehicles.

Mr. Whitney, a resident of Thunder Bay since 1945, joined the Ministry in 1958 following a professional hockey career that included playing for the Hershey Bears, The Quebec Aces and the Victoria Cougars.

He has been with the Highway Carrier Section of the Ministry working in Thunder Bay, Kenora, Oshawa, and Toronto and was appointed Chief Inspector of the Northern Region in 1969

The new Northwestern Region takes in the area from the Manitoba border easterly to White River and covers over 212,000 square miles.

Mr. Whitney will be working with a staff of approximately 40, including a team of commercial vehicle inspectors, that will be checking the safety related mechanical fitness of trucks in the region, on a day-to-day basis.

Two district supervisors, one in Kenora and one in Thunder Bay, will be appointed shortly to oversee driver examinations and the regulations affecting the highway carriers.

NOTICE TO VENDORS-RETAIL SALES TAX

This notice advises all vendors collecting tax under the Retail Sales Tax Act that changes in Retail Sales Tax, proposed in the Ontario Budget on April 9, 1974 and outlined in tax bulletin No. 74-I, are effective to sales made on and after April 29, 1974.

Exemptions on personal hygiene and household cleaning items are listed below. They do not apply to sales to industrial, commercial and institutional organizations.

Exempt personal hygiene items: Babies' skin care preparations; facial tissue; personal deodorants; sanitary pads and tampons; shaving soaps and creams; toilet soap and hand cleaning preparations; toilet tissue; toothpaste; tooth powder; denture cleaners; denture adhesives; non-electric toothbrushes; dental floss.

Exempt household cleaning items: Dust and spot removers; laundry bleaches; starch; blueing; pre-soaks; rinses; fabric softeners; borax and all other preparations for laundering clothes; polishes; waxes and conditioners for floors and furniture; powders and liquids for cleaning walls, floors, tiles, glass, metal, cooking utensils, ovens, sinks, rugs, upholstery, toilet bowls, drains and septic tanks.
